**SHARED EXPENSES** (Updated March 11, 2017)

- 2017 Provincial Conference fees for attending guiders will be shared evenly between Area and District at 50 % each.

**PROVINCE**

- Province will pay uniform support for girls, fees and mileage for provincial trainings, (excluding biennial provincial conference) and events including Trainers weekend, Fall Connections, Young Guider event, Provincial Council meetings, COGS, and special meetings.

**Notes:**

The project is to be evaluated after two years (full evaluation), with potential review at the end of cycles (fiscal or guiding). No major changes are expected to made.

Project guidelines were developed in conjunction with Area Commissioners & DPC Area Commissioner with feedback from the District level.
